I am a tenure-track Assistant Professor of General Psychology at the Department of Life Sciences of the University of Trieste. My research activity focuses on perceptual-cognitive processes related to multisensory stimuli, on complex movements deriving from these processes, as well as on the effects of social influence on the same processes and movements; along basic research, the main field where I study these topics is sport and exercise. At the moment of the candidature, I have 34 Scopus-indexed articles, which received almost 600 citations, for an h-index of 13. I am currently member of the editorial board of 4 journals, and (co-)organized more than 10 international conferences. Since 2019 I have been part of the Managing Council of ENYSSP, serving as coordinator of the Research Department.

After two terms with ENYSSP, I think it is fundamental to renew, refresh and further strengthen the connection and collaboration between FEPSAC and ENYSSP itself, as young researchers and practitioners have a decisive role in fueling the field of sport and exercise psychology. I would like to be the joining link between the two associations, in addition to contributing to the research projects of FEPSAC; another activity I can significantly contribute to is the organization of the conferences, in light of the abovementioned numerous experiences in this regard. “That’s how it’s supposed to be, living young, and in research, and at conferences” ;)
